FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

Dear Parish Family,

A famous American author once wrote: *“If I should ever die, God forbid, let this be my epitaph: the only proof he needed for the existence of God was music.”* There is something with our hearts that speaks to us of the truth of these words. For so many of us, music is not only beautiful but also a conduit for the Divine Presence, music leads us into contemplation of God Himself. Perhaps that is because we experience music here on earth but it will also be part of the life of heaven- the angels and saints sing to God in the heavenly liturgy around *“God’s altar in heaven.”* For this reason, so many people’s experience of the earthly liturgy (Holy Mass) is connected to their experience of music at liturgy. For the past five years, our parish music program has been under the direction of **Kristin Dabaghian**. Kristin notified me last week that she will be resigning her position at St. Paul Church effective the end of July- she will be taking over once again as the assistant organist at the **Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart** in Newark (a job she held years ago). I have come to know Kristin as one of the most talented musicians I have met- I once attended a concert she was giving at the Cathedral Basilica (on the organ she will be playing at Archdiocesan Pontifical liturgies, etc.) and indeed, it was heavenly! We thank Kristin for all of her hard work here at St. Paul, and ask God’s continued blessings upon her future ministry. We will still see Kristen around since she lives in Ramsey and her children are students in our parish Faith Formation and The Academy. I also want to thank all those involved in our Parish Music Ministries: cantors, instrumentalists, Traditional choir, Hosanna Choir, Children’s Choir, and our (growing) Sunday evening Contemporary Ensemble. **I wanted to invite all those involved in our Music Ministry to the parish rectory on Tuesday evening July 17th at 7:30 p.m. for coffee and cake, and an opportunity for us to discuss our Music Ministry moving forward.** I’ve already begun the process of searching for a new **Director of Sacred Music** here at St. Paul. This past week I spent at the **National Pastoral Musicians Convention** in Baltimore, MD interviewing some candidates for the position and getting some ideas. I look forward to all that God has planned for us as we strive to make our parish experience of liturgy meaningful and beautiful.

Next weekend our parish will begin our association with **Bergen Family Promise** as a host congregation for homeless families. I’ve been associated with Family Promise in Essex County (where our parish in Fairfield became a host congregation) and in Union County (where our parish in Springfield became a host congregation). ***I am excited to welcome Bergen Family Promise to St. Paul.*** This organization does wonderful things for homeless families by helping them find homes, employment, schooling for children, etc. The backbone of Family Promise are the host congregations (churches, synagogues, temples, etc.) that agree to host the families on their campus for one week. From **July 22 until July 29**, our parish will host several families here in our Academy building where we will provide shelter, nutritious meals, games for the children, and just a secure place where these families can be together in a loving environment until they can find appropriate housing. The families are vetted by Family Promise and remain at the host site for dinner, overnight, and breakfast the next morning. During the day, Family Promise transports them to their own facilities to help with housing/employment and transports the children to whatever school they attend. The families return again the following evening for dinner. The host congregation is committed to providing comfortable sleeping arrangements (with some opportunity for family privacy), meals, assistance for children (homework help and fun), and friendship. I have enjoyed being involved in Family Promise because while it is a great thing to write a check to help the homeless, it is a different experience entirely to sit across the table from a homeless person and share a meal with them in friendship. The families we will welcome are no different than we are: they are just normal families who temporarily need some help. Please keep the work of Family Promise (and our parish volunteers) in your prayers, and most importantly the families who will be with us who struggle to stay together during a difficult time. ***May the Lord bless us, and may we show our thanksgiving to Him by being a blessing to others in His Name!***
