REFLECTION FROM COLLEEN JAGDE

When the disciples saw him walking on the sea they were terrified. "It is a ghost," they said, and they cried out in fear. At once Jesus spoke to them, "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid."

The command of Jesus is simple, yet difficult...take courage! None of us can walk on water but with the example and trust in Jesus, the guidance of the Holy Spirit and knowing that we are truly loved by our Father, we are destined for great things!

As your Director of Faith Formation, I have the blessing and privilege of meeting hundreds of young people and their families each year. We often hear that the youth are the future of our Church; the truth is we are all responsible for strengthening the Church's foundation, regardless of our age. Our young people are incredible stewards for the Catholic Church and beyond. They heed Jesus' command of take courage seriously and act on it.

Our youth are active serving in our parish community as Faith Formation classroom aides, helping with various parish events, they helped beautify our property, and are always open and willing to help when called upon. They are good stewards in their towns, helping with the Challenger program, Pony Power, visiting healthcare facilities, being tutors, Prayer Partners at the Academy of St. Paul, Relay for Life, helping the elderly, being present and offering their assistance at Ramsey Day and Mahwah Day, just to name of few. Then there is beyond, Allie Z. attended a mission in Bolivia (Love in Action International, a Christian based organization) visiting children in orphanages and performing various upkeep at the orphanages. I am sure traveling to Bolivia without her family, took her way out of her comfort zone. My daughter Kathryn (who attended the Academy of St. Paul) attended a Catholic Heart Work Camp in Cumberland, Maryland. Catholic Heart Work Camp is a Catholic organization that helps the disadvantaged in the United States as well as world-wide. Those that participate in Catholic Heart Work Camp are assigned to work groups that go out to the community to perform various tasks for about 6 to 7 hours per day, similar to Habitat for Humanity. Their mission is to "WORK, SERVE TIRELESSLY, THINK DEEPLY, CELEBRATE MASS and build relationships. You will dance, laugh till your side hurts, pray, change on the inside and be a part of transforming lives and communities FOR CHRIST!" Our youth are involved in numerous service opportunities, this is just a brief outline.

It is my hope and dream that next summer we will have an official service week to bring together our young people in service and prayer. Whether our very own St. Paul Church is our home base or we work with Catholic Heart Work Camp or similar Catholic service organization. If you have any ideas, please reach out to me.

That familiar saying "many hands make light work" is so true, let us take courage and be the hands and feet of Jesus in our Church, local community and beyond! Through our service, we experience true JOY, Jesus (J), Others (O) and You (Y)

It is appropriate for those who have endured rape, incest, or other forms of traumatic violation in childhood, adolescence or as an adult. It is also suitable for those who have suffered spiritual or sexual abuse by a member of the clergy. This model of care provides a powerful therapy for the soul. Grief to Grace will help you identify the ways that past abuse may still impact your spirit as you enter into powerful meditations and reflections that allow your body and mind to be transformed into a new way to trust and appreciation your unique gifts, courage, creativity, and authentic yearning for connection and a supportive community. Embark on an adventure to release the pain and move forward in resurrection, reconciliation and freedom.


