CELEBRATE THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA



The fourth apparition of Our Lady of Fatima occurred on August 19th, 1917—delayed 6 days because the children had been imprisoned. The August apparition occurred in Valinhos; the only apparition not in the Cova. In this apparition, Our Lady instructed the children to continue to pray the rosary for peace and the salvation of souls. Sadly, Our Lady said: "Pray, pray very much, and make sacrifices for sinners, for many souls go to hell, because they have no one to pray and make sacrifices for them."

The Blessed Mother also told the children that "in the last month I will perform a miracle so all will believe." She also said that the miracle would have been greater had the children not been imprisoned.

THE MONTH OF AUGUST DEDICATED TO THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

The Church dedicates the month of August to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. "It is a dogma of the Catholic faith that Mary is the Immaculate Conception; that is, in preparation for the Incarnation of the Second Person of the Holy Trinity in her womb, she was conceived without the corruption of sin through the infinite merits of her Son, Jesus Christ. "Through testimony of saints and theologians, devotion to Our Lady's purity of heart grew and in the 17th century, St. John Eudes promoted it alongside the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The devotion rose to a new level after the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima, when Mary revealed an image of her Immaculate Heart to Lucia, Jacinta, and Francisco.





FAITH FORMATION

Enrollment in the St. Paul Faith Formation Program is offered to all registered parishioners who participate in the sacramental life of the church and most especially Sunday Eucharist. The Program is open to all Parish children in Kindergarten through Grade 8, who are not in Catholic School.

Our goal is to give the children the opportunity to build their faith which is grounded in God's love, family experience, the witness of others and is brought to fruition as we celebrate as a parish family of faith, especially when we celebrate the Eucharist.



The Adults and Children Together Program (ACT) meets on Sunday Mornings once per month. This gives families the opportunity to attend Faith Formation as

an entire family. Children in grades Kindergarten through grade 8 are welcome to enroll in this program. There are two program times offered to help families with scheduling, one group meets at 8:15 am and the other at 10:15 am.

The children gather and break out into peer groups with a Catechist, while the parents/adults have their own faith gathering.

The Faith in Action Program is more of a "traditional" program model.

Grades 1 through 4 will meet on Mondays after school from 4:00 pm to 5:30 pm. Grades 5 through 8 will meet on Monday evenings from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Most of the curriculum is covered in the classroom setting and facilitated by trained, volunteer Catechists.


