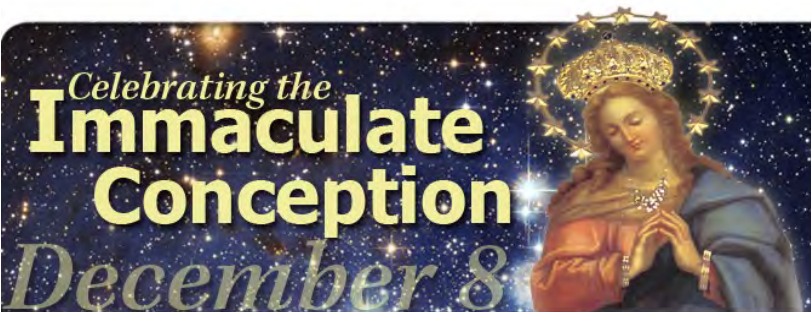

## FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

Finally it has arrived..... the *Season of Advent!* This is my favorite season of all, everything about it charms me (the colors, the sights and smells, the Scriptures, and the entire sense of the season). Unfortunately, with Christmas falling on a Monday this year, Advent is as short as it can possibly be. The entire Fourth Week of Advent will be virtually non-existent since the Fourth Sunday of Advent is also Christmas Eve. Therefore, we have to pack an extra amount of reflecting and celebrating Advent in a shorter time, so it's important we get cracking!

The perpetual problem with Advent, however, is Christmas! The secular world begins Christmas marketing in late summer, and by October Christmas seems almost in full swing. Therefore, Advent is so often swallowed up by Christmas, and for Christians that is a shame. Advent is more than just Christmas preparation, it is a season with its own message. It's only in the last few days of Advent that the Church turns our attention to the birth of the Christ Child in Bethlehem. Until that time, Advent is about reflection on the *Second Coming of an Adult Christ*, and our need for preparation. We prepare, not with trees and cookies and nicely wrapped gifts, we prepare with lives lived in holiness and prayer, so that when Christ comes He will recognize His disciples not in an ocean of wrapping paper but in the light of faith. There are many opportunities for growth in faith during this Advent - one of the most important and beneficial things we can do is to try to attend Holy Mass a bit more frequently, perhaps once or twice extra during the week in addition to Sunday. Then, we can get a beautiful sense of the unfolding of the Advent scriptures, and spend some time in quiet contemplation in this season of busy-ness and business. And remember: this year we cannot let the *Fourth Sunday of Advent* become an afterthought. The temptation will be for some to simply go to Mass on Christmas Eve and allow that to "count" for the Fourth Sunday of Advent also, but this would be to cut corners with the God who never cuts corners with us, but always gives of Himself in utterly generous self-gift. I ask you to make yourself aware of the Mass schedule during these holy days and be ambassadors for Christ, inviting others to come to His house during this sacred season.

In a special way, I'd like to invite the children of the parish to join me in *Church for the Feast of St. Nick* on Wednesday, December 6<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. We will have a special evening for "*Children of Hope: Eucharistic Adoration*" when we will do what St. Nicholas did- contemplate Christ and speak with Him in prayer. This year again we will take part in the Dutch custom of filling children's shoes with small candies and gifts- we ask the children to bring their slippers, leaving their shoes in the Church sacristy and wearing their slippers into Church. All are invited, the young in years and the young at heart, to come and celebrate this great saint! And be sure to mark your calendars for our first of *two Christmas Concerts this year*: On December 17<sup>th</sup> (Sunday afternoon) we will get together for a concert presented by our parish Music Ministry followed by an outdoor lighting of the parish Christmas Tree and a Sing-Along, followed by a Christmas Open House in the rectory for some hot chocolate. Our *second Christmas Concert* will take place on Sunday, January 7<sup>th</sup> (the Feast of the Epiphany/Baptism of the Lord weekend) when the Franciscan Sisters of St. Elizabeth will join with the Stardust Big Band (who played for us last summer outdoors behind the Church) for a beautiful afternoon that will help us to end the Season of Christmas in song and celebration. The secular world puts Christmas away on December 26<sup>th</sup>, and especially after New Year's Day, but we savor the season and keep celebrating as long as we can. This and other parish events will help to make our Advent Season a true time of peace. I hope you join us! Also, families of children/young adults with *Special Needs are invited to a special Mass* on Sunday afternoon December 10<sup>th</sup>. We will celebrate Mass and allow each person to participate according to their comfortability level, and together we will enjoy the company of one another and Christ. *Last but not least, I want to thank all those who helped me celebrate my 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Ordination to the Lord's priesthood. I couldn't think of a better place to celebrate it than St. Paul Church in Ramsey! Please continue to pray for me.*
