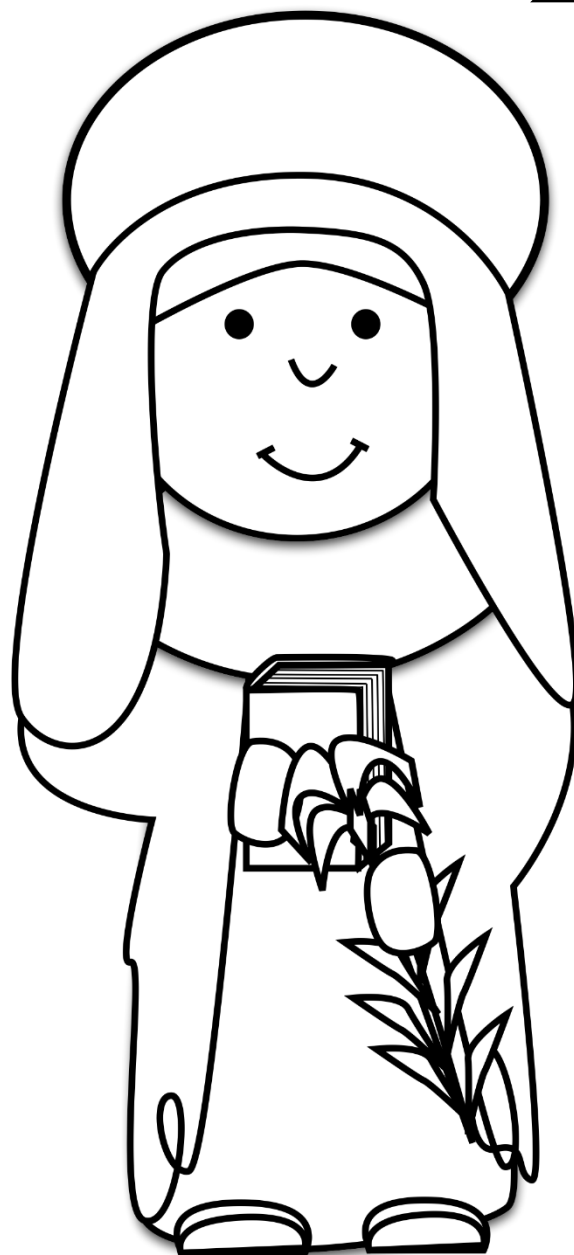

PATRON: NURSES

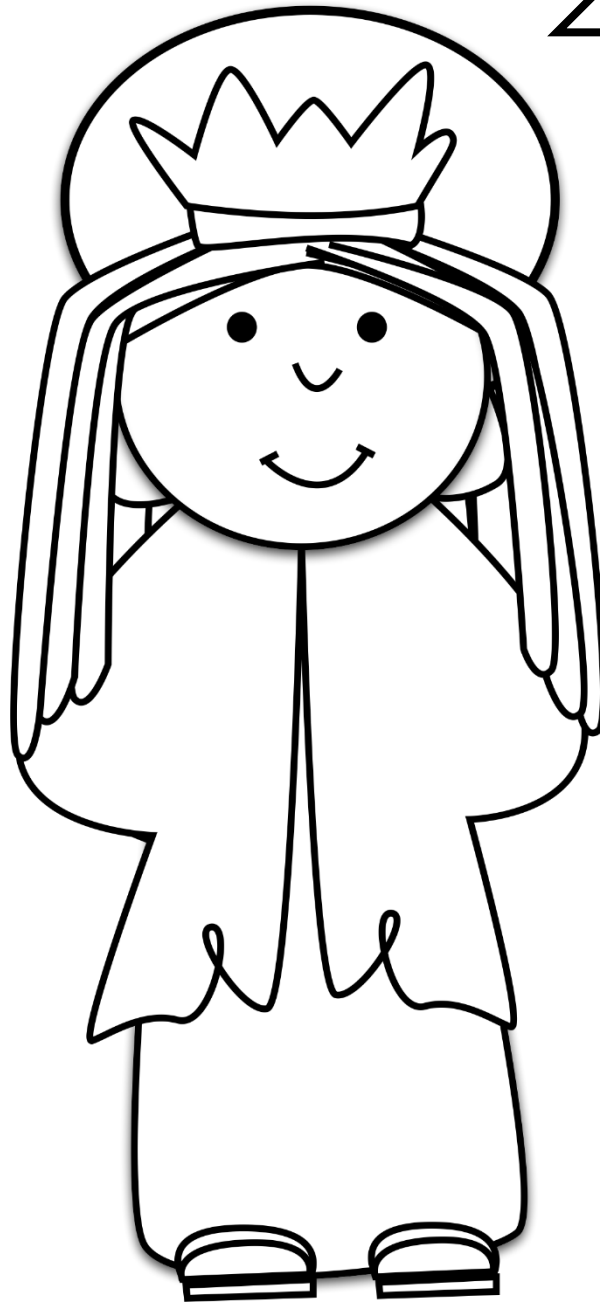


St. Catherine of Siena

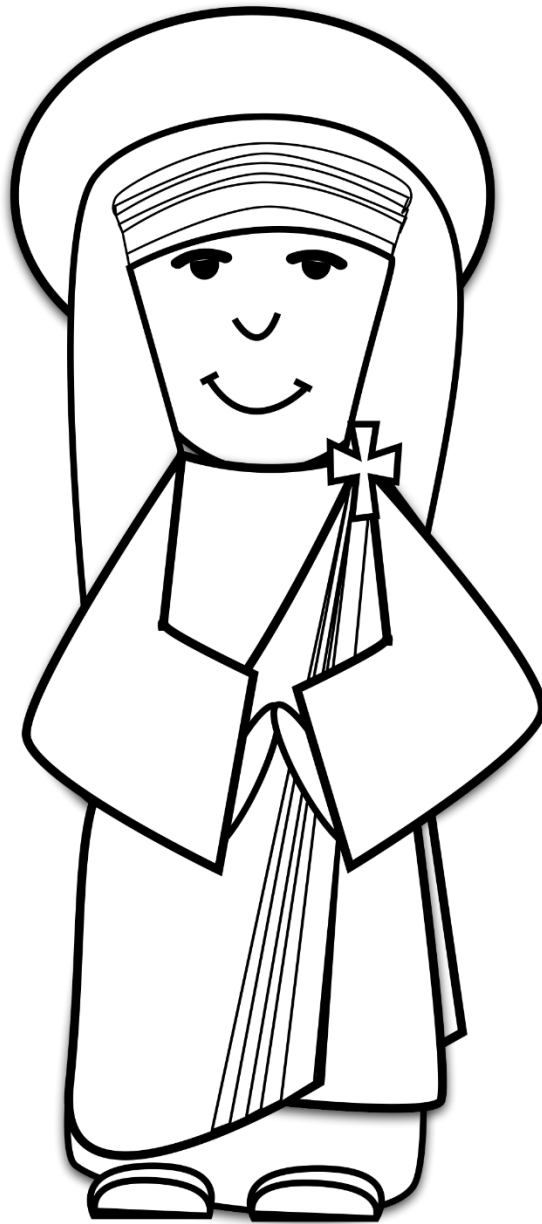
St. Pope John Paul II
